

MARATHON 2004

You're invited to join a team of cyclists, aged 16 and above, taking on a 630 km Bike for Bibles challenge. You'll enjoy beautiful countryside along with the warm hospitality of locals.

Perth to Pinjarra	87 km
Pinjarra to Williams	124 km
Williams to Kojonup	65 km
Kojonup to Wagn	94 km
Wagn to Brookton	122 km
Brookton to Perth	138 km
Total	630 km

The Marathon team will cycle at an average pace of around 25 km per hour, depending on the conditions.

Most evenings will be spent with local church members. We'll either be billeted in their homes or sleeping in church halls.

A support vehicle driven by 'roadies' will carry all luggage, first aid, food, spares and mechanical equipment. All you need to carry on your bike is a water bottle.

This is a fundraising event and all participants are required to fund raise from friends and family prior to the ride. The fundraising target set for this ride is \$800 which has proved to be a very reasonable and reachable target so don't let it daunt you. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible.

A \$25 registration fee is due with your registration form. On Road Costs of \$95 are required prior to the ride commencing (this will cover your transport, food & accommodation).

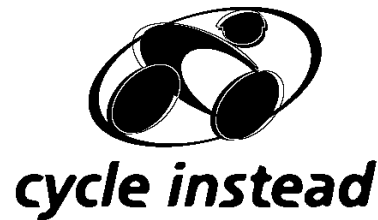

- 1) I understand that Bike for Bibles is not a race but a team fund raising event.
- 2) I guarantee that I will make every effort to fund raise the target of \$800. I understand that as Bike for Bibles is primarily a fund raising event, my participation may depend upon my fund raising efforts.
- 3) I am aware that the organisers, venue providers, sponsors and all other persons involved in Bike for Bibles are exempt and indemnified of any claim I might make against them resulting from hazards during the event.
- 4) I understand my responsibility regarding my behaviour in respect to the safety and enjoyment of fellow participants and agree to abide by the directions of the leadership and the regulations as listed hereunder.
